



Prior Authorization Considerations

Use this checklist to help you with the AKEEGA® (niraparib and abiraterone acetate) Prior Authorization (PA) process to reduce fulfillment delays.

1) Benefits Investigation (BI)

Submit a completed BI to payer(s)

Identify payer PA requirements outlined in coverage determination

Note: Consider enrolling your patient in AKEEGA withMe

2) Diagnosis

ICD-10-CM and date of diagnosis

Patient medical records

Diagnostic test and imaging results

Severity of patient's condition, including comorbidities or intolerance to other therapies

3) Clinical Information

Patient history of therapy:

- Must have one of the following:

Combination treatment involving a hormone analog

OR

Procedure(s)

- Must be on continuity of therapy

- Clinical rationale for requested medication (guidelines/provider's plan for patient)

Reduce the chance of denial by submitting the following information (with a Letter of Medical Necessity, if required):

In the event the PA is denied, additional payer denials and appeals resources can be found at www.akeegahcp.com.

- Physician/facility name, provider ID, tax ID
- Procedure and HCPCS codes for products/services
- Product Prescribing Information and NDC
- Medical need and reason(s) for medication
- Patient's history & physical findings
 - Previously administered treatment(s)/procedure(s) and dates, including tried and failed prior medications/therapies
 - Recent symptoms and condition
 - Physician opinion of patient prognosis or disease progression
